SECTION 31(6) - THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

- 1. I am required to deposit with you, under the provisions of Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1980, this plan showing Ministry of Defence owned land within your area outlined in bold black upon which have been marked all the ways which the Secretary of State for Defence recognises as public highways.
- 2. I am to confirm that the extent of the public rights recognised by the Secretary of State for Defence over each route shown on the plan is as follows:
 - a) Over each route shown by a continuous purple line, the Secretary of State recognises a highway over which the public have rights of way on foot only.
 - b) Over each route shown by a continuous green line, the Secretary of State recognises that the public have the following but no other rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.
 - c) Over each route shown by a broken green line, the Secretary of State recognises the way to be a highway other than a footpath or bridleway used by the public mainly for the purposes for which footpaths or bridleways are used, or as a byway open to all traffic.
 - d) Over each route shown by a continuous brown tint, the Secretary of State recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.
- 3. Of the above highways, those described in sub-paragraphs a), b) and c) are more particularly described in the highways definitive statement as prepared by the County Council.
- A Statutory Declaration will be lodged with you shortly and then renewed from time to time as appropriate.

- I, BASIL JOHN RITCHIE, for and on behalf of THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENCE (hereinafter referred to as the Secretary of State), and acting under the authority conferred upon me by the Secretary of State DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:



- 3. The above highways described in sub-paragraphs a), b) and c) are more particularly described in the highway definitive statement as prepared by the relevant Council.
