

STATUTORY DECLARATION

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 31 (6)

I SARAH PRIESTMAN DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 8 January 1991 the owner of the land known as Holmwood Park, Dorking, Surrey more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 7 of March 1992 the Woodland Trust deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that no ways had been dedicated as highways over our property.
3. On the 6 day of March 1998 my predecessor in title Wendy Higlett deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration dated 6 March 1998 stating that no additional ways had been dedicated since the deposit of the statement referred to in 2 above.
4. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the date of the statutory declaration referred to in 3 above and at the present time the Woodland Trust has no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over its property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 7 day of January 2004 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
