

STATUTORY DECLARATION

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 31 (6)

I AVERIL HAROLD DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 22 April 1993 the owner of the land known as Staffhurst Wood, Limpsfield more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 19 June 2000 the Woodland Trust deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration stating that no additional ways [other than those marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration] had been dedicated as footpaths since the deposit of the statement 20 June 1994.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statutory declaration referred to in 2 above [other than those footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration] and at the present time the Woodland Trust has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 26 day of April, 2010 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.

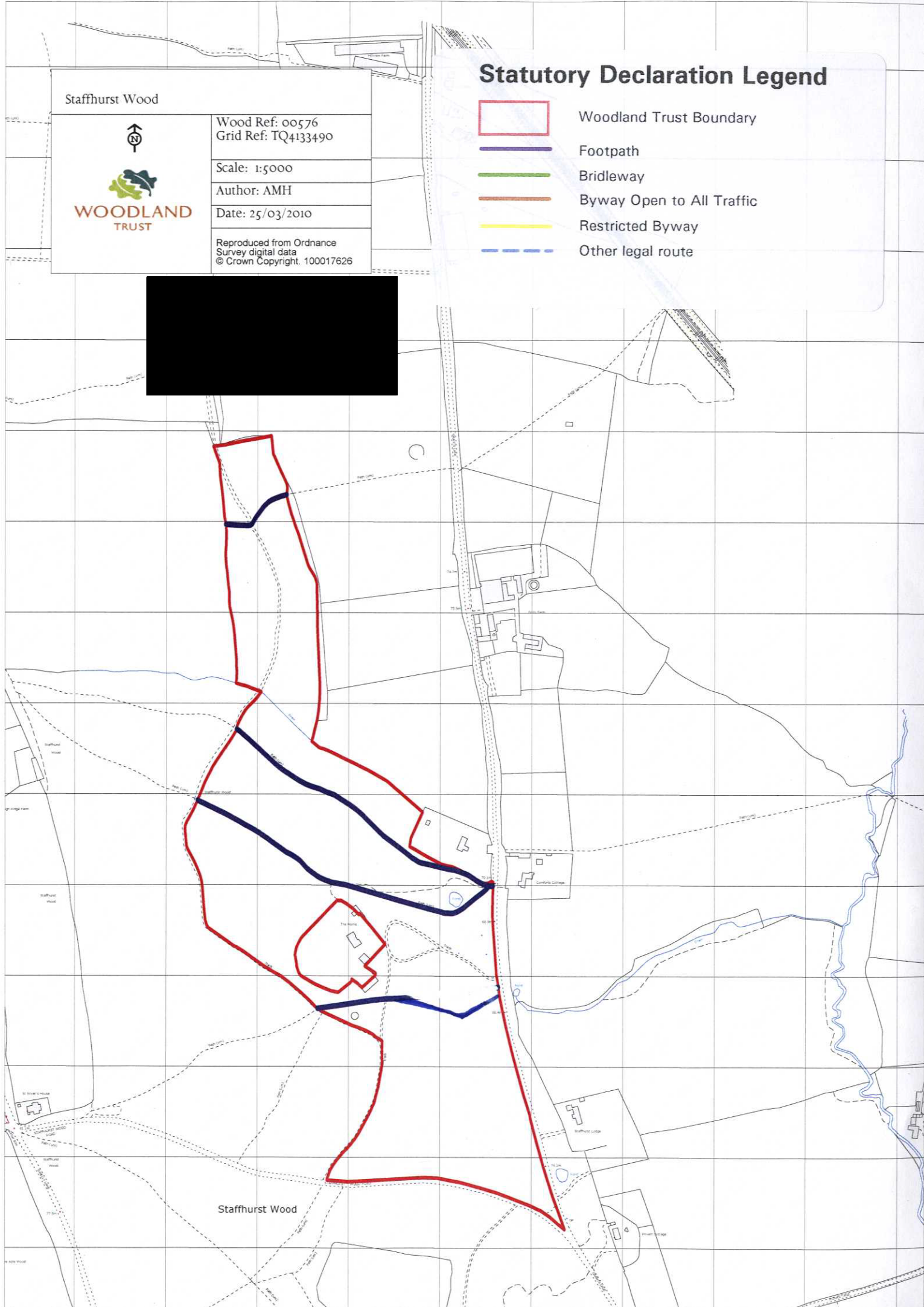
