

DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT and PLAN
SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

To Surrey County Council

1. St John, the Evangelist, Dormansland was erected on the site in 1882.

I, Rev. Graham Paddick, as Incumbent Vicar represent the Parochial Church Council of St John, the Evangelist, Dormansland, and Southwark Diocese, the owners within the meaning of the above section of the land known as St John, the Evangelist, Dormansland more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this statement and thereon edged red.
2. The aforementioned land lies in the Parish of Dormansland.
3. The ways coloured brown on the said plan have been dedicated as highways with public vehicular status.
4. In accordance with the provisions of Section 31 of the Highways act 1980, the Parochial Church Council declare that there are no other public rights of way of any sort over the aforesaid land nor do they recognise any other such public right of way whatsoever.
5. Upon the said plan there is marked in blue a path for which the Parochial Church Council have given consent to members of the public to walk over. However, this path is not being dedicated to the public at large to use.
6. The deposit shall comprise this statement and accompanying plan.


