STATUTORY DECLARATION SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980


I, Rev. Graham Paddick, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-

- I, Rev. Graham Paddick, as Incumbent Vicar represent the Parochial Church Council of St John, the Evangelist, Dormansland, and Southwark Diocese, the owners of St. John, the Evangelist, Dormansland since 1882, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
- 2. On the tenth day of January two thousand and six, I deposit with Surrey County Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating St. John, the Evangelist, Dormansland by red edging which stated that the ways coloured brown on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as highways with public vehicular status.
- 3. Upon the said plan there is marked in blue a path for which St. John, the Evangelist, Dormansland, give consent to members of the public to walk over. However, this path is not being dedicated to the public at large to use.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the tenth day of January two thousand and six, conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
