

STATUTORY DECLARATION
SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I, RICHARD ANTHONY ROY ASHBY of Hawkins Farm , Stovolds Hill, Cranleigh Surrey **DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE** as follows:

1. I am and have been since 8th December 1995 the owner jointly with others of the land known as Land on the West Side of Stovolds Hill, Cranleigh, Surrey, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 12th day of October 1998 I deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that no ways had been dedicated as highways with vehicular status nor as bridleways nor as footpaths over my property.
3. No ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 9th October 1998 referred to in 2 above either as highways with vehicular status bridleways or footpaths and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the *14th* day of *October* 1998 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
