I, Kathleen McAlmont of Pucks Oak, Compton, Guildford, Surrey do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows:-

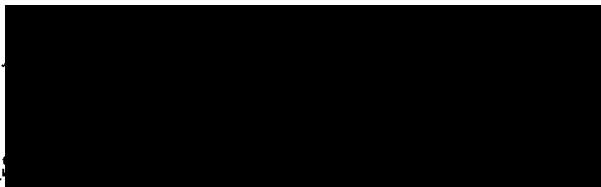
1. I, Chairman of the Elizabeth McAlmont Memorial Trust, maintainers of the woodland known as the Compton Ancient Glebe Wood, with full powers to act on behalf of the Diocese of Guildford enclose plans of the said woodland which is coloured pink on the attached plan marked.
2. Upon said plan there is marked in purple, Public Footpaths namely rights of Way numbers.
3. In accordance with provisions of Section 31 of the Highways Act 1980, I declare that there are no other Public Rights of Way of any sort over the aforesaid land, nor do I recognise any other such Public Rights of Way whatsoever.
4. Upon the said plan there is marked in blue a path for which I have given consent to members of the public to walk over. However, this path is not being dedicated as a Public Right of Way.

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declaration Act 1835.

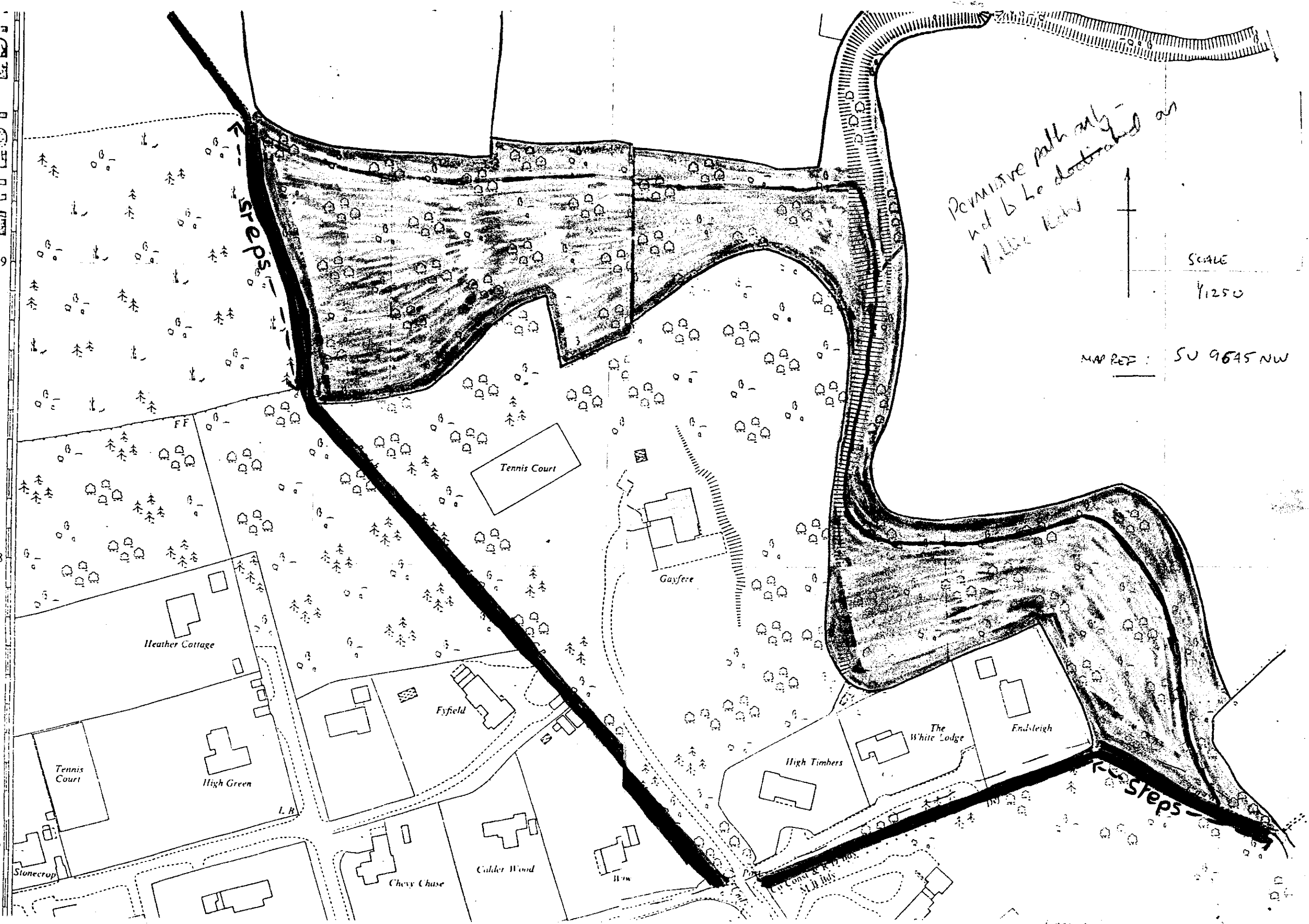
