- 2. Under the said plan marked on Map B, are marked in Red, Public Footpaths, namely designated Public Rights of Way Numbers: 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 66 & 69.
- 3. In accordance with the provisions of Section 31 of the Highways Act 1980, the National Trust for Places of Historic Interest or Natural Beauty declare that there are no other rights of way of any sort over the aforesaid land nor do the National Trust for Places of Historic Interest or Natural Beauty recognise any other such public right of way whatsoever.
- 4. Upon the said plan, marked on Map B, there are marked, in Blue, a number of paths for which the National Trust for Places of Historical Interest or Natural Beauty give consent to members of the General Public to walk over, subject to other access restrictions as pursuant to the Egham Enclosure Act 1814. However, these paths are not being dedicated to the public at large to use.
