- 2. On the 8th day of November 2013 I deposited with Surrey Council, being the appropriate council, a statement accompanied by a map showing the London Borough of Merton's property edged red which stated that:

no other ways had been dedicated as highways over the London Borough of Merton's property.

- 3. On the 8th day of November 2013 I deposited with Surrey Council, being the appropriate council, a declaration dated 8th November 2013, stating that no additional ways other than those marked in the appropriate colour on the map accompanying that declaration had been dedicated as footpaths since the deposit of the statement referred to in paragraph 2 above.
- 4. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the map accompanying this declaration/referenced in paragraph 1 above since the statement dated 8th November 2013 referred to in paragraph 2 above other than those footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the map accompanying this declaration and at the present time the London Borough of Merton has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over the property.

- 1. The land is let to a local farmer, Stephen Conisbee, under the terms of a Farm Business Tenancy dated 14 January 2013. It is the second such agreement to be entered into by him, the first being dated 26th April 2005.
- 2.Under the terms of the Farm Business Tenancy the Land (including that part of the holding referred to as Common Meadow) is to be used for agricultural purposes as permanent pasture and there is a contractual obligation on the Tenant to fence and enclose field boundaries (which excludes the area referred to as Common Meadow) with stock proof fencing and to maintain field gateways and public rights of way and the public's right of light air and access to Common Meadow.
- 3. The public footpaths referred to in Part B and Part C of the application have been marked with the appropriate signage on posts although in some locations these have been vandalised and removed. Any permissive footpaths across the Land have been labelled on the stiles and gates as "Permissive Footpath no public right of way" and the paths are closed for 24 hours in any 12 month period and records kept of such closures. Apart from the area referred to as Common Meadow there is no lawful right to use any part of the land for sports and pastimes.


