

**STATUTORY DECLARATION  
SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

I, **JUNE ELIZABETH JANET GREEN (nee SPAREY)** formerly of 138 Upper College Ride, Old Dean, Camberley, Surrey, GU15 4HA but now of "Solva" 17 Baskerville Lane, Lower Shiplake, Henley-on-Thames, Oxon RG9 3JY **DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-**

1. The Windlesham United Charities & Poors Allotments Registered Charity Number 200224 have been since 1898 the owner of the land known as Windlesham Poors Allotments, Bagshot, Surrey, which is more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 27th day of February 1998 I deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating the property by red edging which stated that (the ways coloured green on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths).
2. On the 27th day of February 1998 I deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration dated the 27th day of February 1998 stating that no additional ways (other than those coloured on the plan accompanying this declaration) had been dedicated as (highways with vehicular status) (bridleways) (footpaths) since the deposit of the Statement referred to in 2 above.

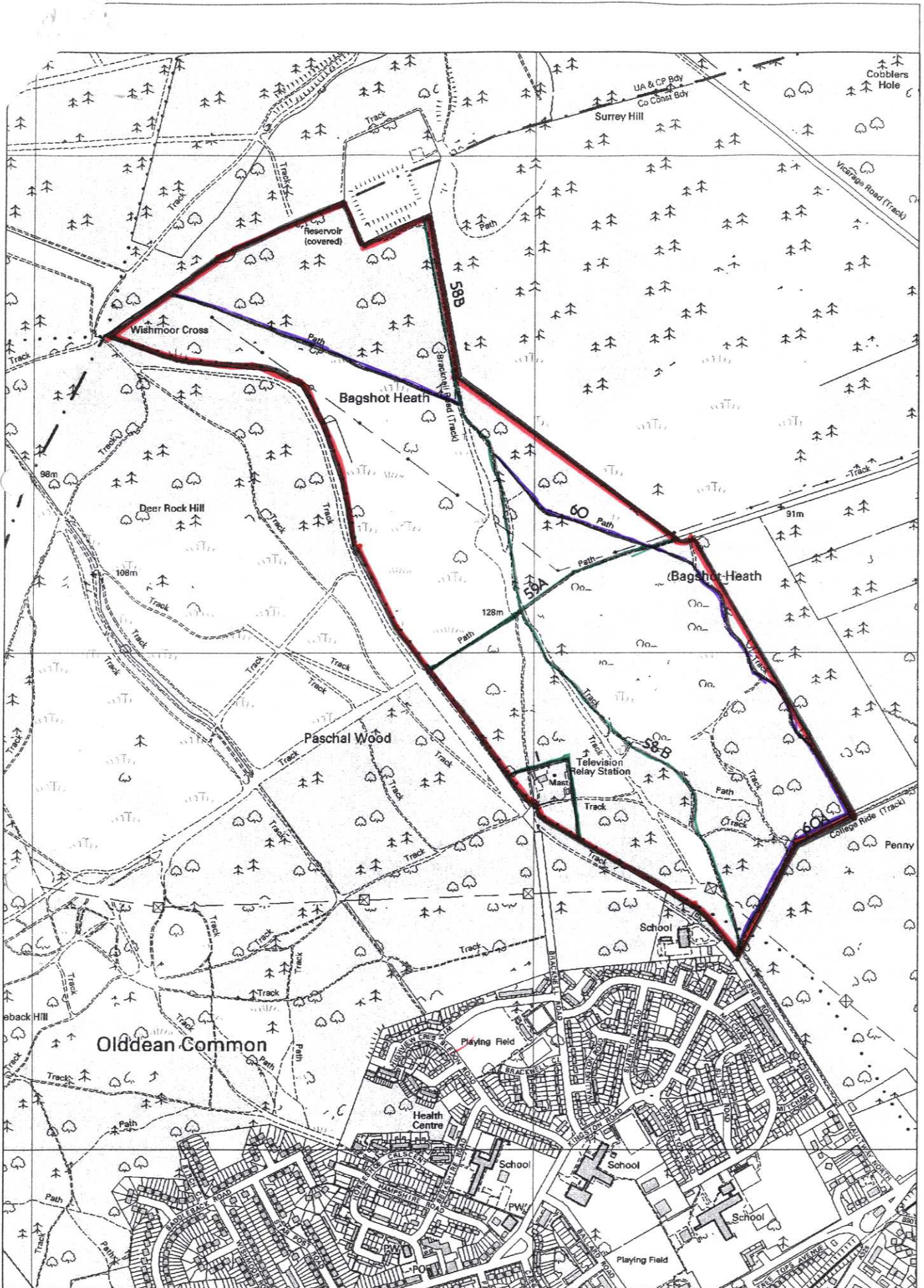
