

STATUTORY DECLARATION
SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I STANLEY EDWIN STONARD of Penquite Farm, Wykehurst Lane, Ewhurst, Surrey **DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE** as follows:

1. I am and have been since 7th September 1984 the owner jointly with others of the land known as Penquite Farm, Wykehurst Lane, Ewhurst, Surrey more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
- READ* 2. On the *22nd* day of *January* 1998 I deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that the way coloured brown on the plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as a footpath but that no other ways had been dedicated as highways with vehicular status nor as bridleways nor as footpaths over my property.
- READ* 3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated *19th January* 1998 referred to in 2 above and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the *23rd* day of *January* 1998 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
