

STATUTORY DECLARATION
SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I CHRISTOPHER RICHARD MILES of Stable Cottage Court Lodge Farm Bletchingley Surrey as agent for and on behalf of the landowners ("the Landowners") of the land known as land at Court Lodge Farm, Bletchingley, Surrey more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-

1. On the 31st day of July 2000 I on behalf of the Landowners deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating the Landowners' property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration has been dedicated as footpaths.
2. On the 31st day of July 2000 I on behalf of the Landowners deposited with Surrey County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration dated 31st July 2000, stating that no additional ways had been dedicated as footpaths since the deposit of the Statement referred to in 1 above.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 31st July 2000 referred to in 1 above and since the date of the statutory declaration referred to in 2 above.
4. Upon the said plan there is marked in green a path for which I have given consent to members of the public to walk over. However this path is not being dedicated to the public at large to use.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 31st day of July 2000 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
