

I, IAN LINDSEY WELCH of the Department of the Environment, for and on behalf of THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENCE, and acting under the authority conferred upon me by the said Secretary of State DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-

1. The Secretary of State for Defence on various dates between 22 December 1977 and 20 March 1979 acting in accordance with Section 34(6) of The Highways Act of 1959 caused to be deposited with The Surrey County Council maps of certain Establishments vested in the said Secretary of State within the area administered by such Council and statements indicating what ways (if any) over that land the Secretary of State admitted to have been dedicated as highways. The plans were based on the Ordnance Survey and consisted of the following sheet numbers:-

2. Acting now in accordance with Section 31(6) of the Highways Act of 1980, the said Secretary of State hereby declares that no additional way other than the way described in the Schedule herein contained and indicated on the plans annexed to this Declaration over the land delineated on the maps so deposited with the Surrey County Council has been dedicated as a highway since the 22 of December 1977.

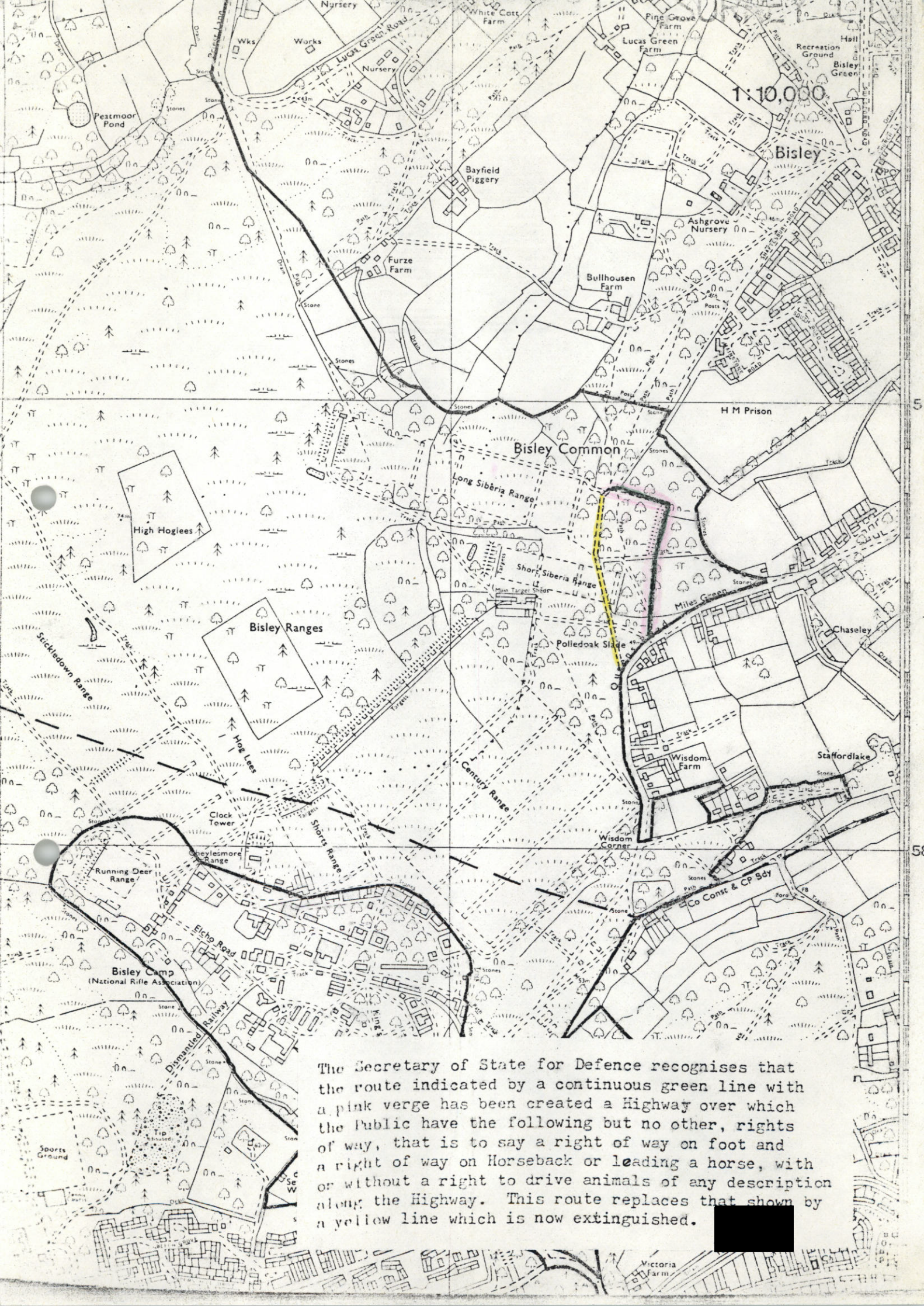
AND I MAKE this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the provisions of the Statutory Declarations Act of 1835.

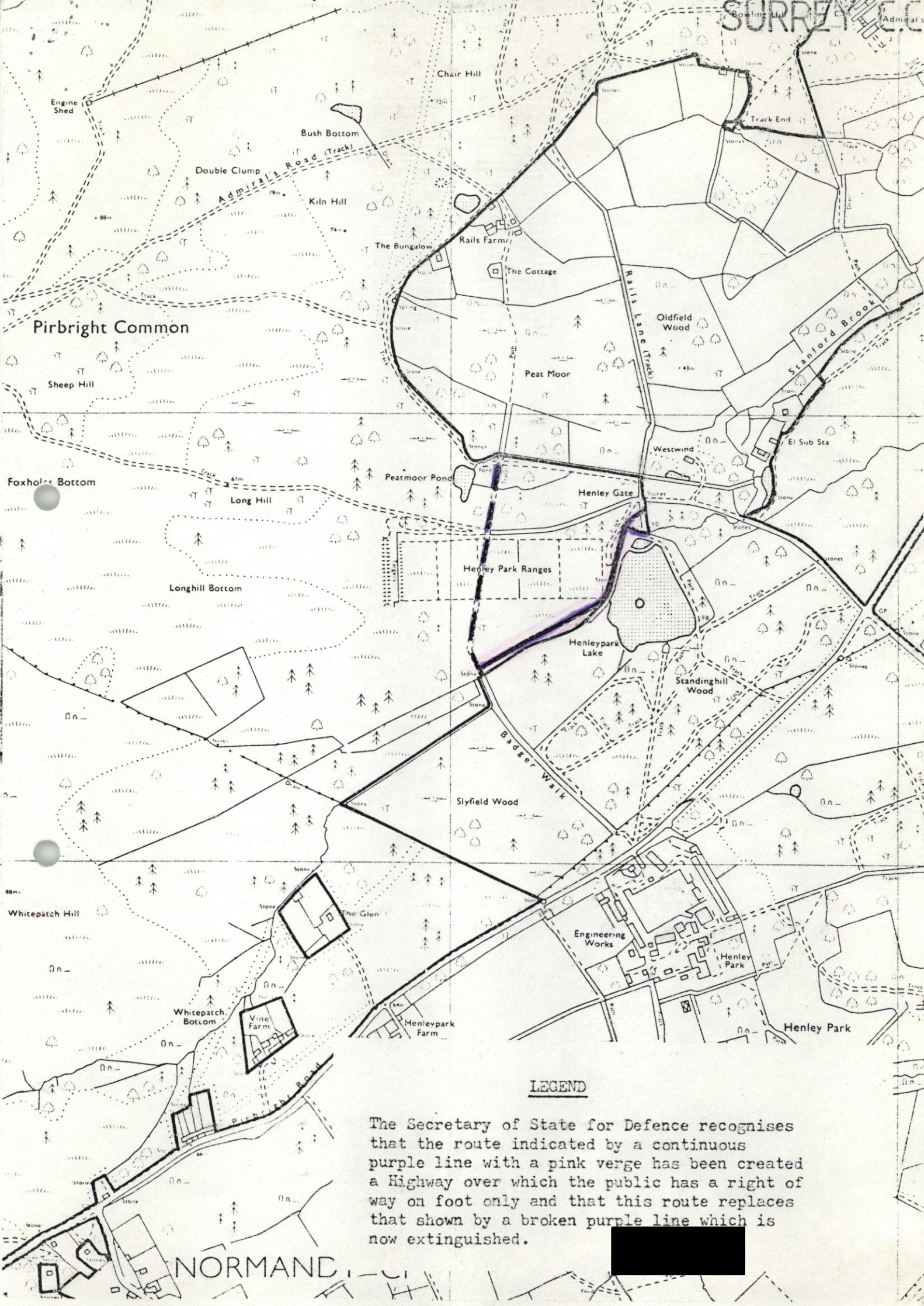

The Secretary of State for Defence recognises that the route indicated by a continuous green line with a pink verge has been created a Highway over which the Public have the following but no other, rights of way, that is to say a right of way on foot and a right of way on Horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the Highway. This route replaces that shown by a yellow line which is now extinguished.
