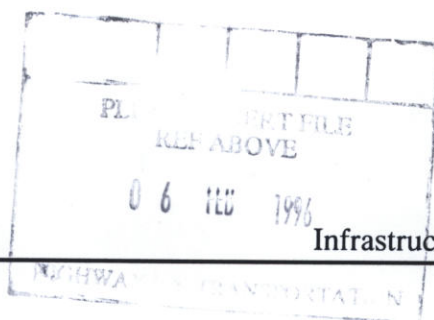

HOLMWOOD TO OCKLEY RAILWAY
YOUNGS CATTLE CREEP BRIDGE AT 28m 40c FOOTPATH 155/156

With reference to the above I wrote to your Highways and Transportation Department at Reigate in November 1995 to establish that the way under the above bridge would be protected against the acquisition of any additional public rights and was advised at that time that the matter had been referred to your Mrs Patricia Birch.

As it may be that the letter went astray when forwarded to you, I would repeat the points contained with regard to protection of the way against other public rights.

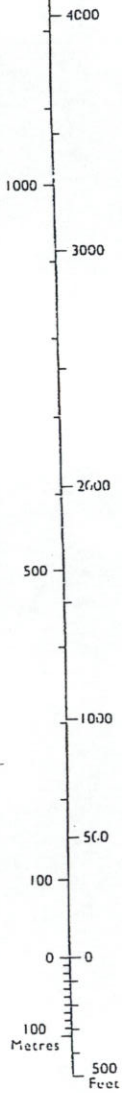
There has been concern in the past that other users' rights should not be acquired and to protect the status quo, signs were erected under Section 31(3) of the Highways Act 1980 at the above bridge site on 16 July 1984 which stated that the way was not Dedicated to the public save as a footpath.

A recent inspection has revealed that these signs have been removed by persons unknown and I am writing to ask that you record in accordance with Section 31(5) of the HA 1980 that Railtrack has no intention to dedicate the way under the bridge to any higher status than public footpath.

I would be obliged if you could confirm as soon as possible that the County has registered Railtrack's intentions. I enclose an extract of an O.S. map indicating the location of the bridge for your ease of reference.
